Prof Partha S. Chatterjee, Hon'ble MLC, Deptt of Edn, Govt of WB, & Chairman, Board of Governors presides over the meeting.  
The following resolutions are unanimously adopted in the meeting today.

1. The proceedings / resolutions of the meeting of 31.10.09 are read and confirmed.
2. The Secretary placed the report of the following apprentices through proper advertisement and interviewed.

Sri Majumder as a very senior experienced person in the field of T&P has been granted consolidated monthly salary of Rs 30,000/- and Rs 20,000/- for food, refreshment & accommodation on 100% as per rules. In addition,

he will be provided a free car to attend kolkata office from his residence as well as for visit of corporate offices in and around kolkata.

Further it is reported that offer letter to Dr. Partha Pratim Bhattacharya, Principal, Greater Kolkata College of Engineering and Management, Barrackpore, has been given for the post of Principal of BVIE on the basis of his application & interview but Dr. Bhattacharya has declined to join the post.

It is further reported that Indranath Chatterjee appointed & serving as Asst TPO has resigned from his post. This meeting accepts the resignation.

Incidentally, Advertisement for the Principal, Faculty as well as Asst TPO has already been issued. This meeting apposes the same.

3. The Secretary places the report of results of Exams of 1<sup>st</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> & 7<sup>th</sup> Semester, 2009. The result is considered and found satisfactory.

4. The Secretary places the report regarding present position of the ongoing construction work. On review it is noted construction of 2nd Girls' Hostel and the Deptt of Electrical Engineering has been completed and is in use. Payment has also been made. The construction of Library cum Central Lab is in progress nearly 85% work is completed.

5. In view of resolution no 2 of BOG meeting dt 19.09.09 and no 2 of BOG meeting dt 31.10.09, it is reported Dr. Jayotirmoy Mukhopadhyay, RT Prince A.P.C. College, Aza Barrackpore No.

Education was appointed vide our ref no 1E/09/x/09 dt 11.10.09 to act as Enquiry officer to enquire into the charges as contained in to the letter of Suspension of three placement officers of our college in the T.o.t. sept 4 in the context of forging and cheating regarding placements of our students at HCL Technologies Ltd. The period of enquiry was initially one month ending on 10.11.09. on the basis of request of the Enquiry officer and in consultation with the Chairman B.o.g, following three extensions of the period of Enquiry were granted

All the above extensions are considered and approved in the this meeting.

6. The Secretary reports that Dr. Jayashri Raychaudhury, the enquiry officer submitted the enquiry report on 10.03.2010 regarding enquiry as assigned to him in respect of charges against the suspended officers namely Asstt. Kumer Bandyopadhyay ETPO, Anubab Kumar Choudhury ATPO and Sujoy Chatterjee TPO posted at Kolkata Office of our Training and Placement Department in the matter of forging and cheating in the context of placement of our students at HCL Technologies Ltd.

The Secretary now formally places the report in this meeting of BOG. Members take part in the discussion in details, make Scrutiny of each and every part of it, specially the concluding part of each of the suspended offices and considering the serious nature of the matter unanimously resolves to undertake briefly the following steps and measures.

Report of enquiry is placed and studied and it has been found that all the three suspended officers of Training & Placement department of our college, namely Asstt Kumas Bandyopadhyay ATPO, Arnab Kumar Choudhury ATPO and Sujay Chatterjee TPO posted at Kocchata office, have deliberately, conspiratorially and over a considerable period of time committed wrongful actions, - cheating & forging against the institute and the students on the matter of placement of students at HCT Technological Ltd during the period of July 2008 - June 2009 and thereby have betrayed the trust of the Institute and damaged the interests of the students. It is therefore resolved that they would be asked to show cause within seven days from the receipt of the letter, as to why they will not be discharged from their services in this institute with immediate effect. In case they fail or refuse to reply satisfactorily in time, unilateral action will have to be taken by the Board of Governors of Bandhu Manjari

7. It is resolved that Dr. Jayashree Mukhopadhyay, the Enquiry officer would be requested to accept Rs 300/- as a token honorarium.

8. The Secretary reports about Students unrest in the context of placement matters of final year students. Though most of companies both post and on campus are arranged, unfortunately the rate of success is very much unsatisfactory. Following chain of events in other colleges, our students also went on agitation and <sup>from</sup> 15th March, 2010 they began hunger strike. However the Secretary and the Hon'ble Chairman met with them and in a meeting along with TPO, the matter has been resolved on following line understanding.

(i)

The Board of governors would take all possible measures to get our accredited with big corporate companies like TCS and so on - needed as per requirement to be identified by the newly appointed TPO.

(ii) In the meantime all attempts should be made to arrange ~~placement~~ <sup>placements</sup> on campus programme of middle order companies.

(iii) The College and T&P. department would continue to arrange placement programme for these final year students even after their final examination.

9. The Secretary places the Audit Report of 2008-09. The members' enquires are met and after thorough discussion, it is approved.

10. The Registrar's letter seeking permission to perform Consultant service for Videocon sponsored Solar Energy Project at Raghunathpur is read and permission is granted on condition that no remuneration or honorarium should be enjoyed except incidental charges.

11. For better office work and liaison with Govt, University, AICTE and Corporate Companies for placements, it is resolved that from the next semester, the weekly holiday would be Sunday & Monday instead of Wednesday & Thursday.

12. The Chairman, Board of Governors places the letter of resignation of Prof Bobwantrao Kayal from the post of Secretary on health ground. He also informs the mother organisation has discussed the matter and is of the opinion that the resignation may be accepted and in his place Prof Pratip Mukherjee has been nominated for selection to the post of Secretary, Board of Governors.

The meeting of the Board of Governors under the circumstances accepts the resignation of Prof Bobwantrao Kayal from the post of Secretary and accepts the election of Prof Pratip Mukherjee as Secretary unanimously as the next Secretary of Board of Governors. While accepting the resignation, the BOG recognises with deep appreciation the significant contribution of Prof Kayal in all round developments
