Prof Niranjan Hargre, chairman, B.O.G. presided over the meeting.

Agenda No-1: confirmation of the last meeting held on 23/12/14.

Proceeding of the B.O.G meeting no-60 held on 18th July, 2014 is read over, discussed and confirmed.

Agenda no-2: - Present status of TEDIP-II project

Agenda no-2 is taken up for discussion. TEDIP co-ordinator Subhajit Roy reported the different activities of TEDIP. He elaborated and highlighted the following area.

- i) Till May 2015 Rs 950 Lacs is received and total expenditure as on date is 894.676 Lacs.
- ii) Till May 2015 the total expenditure on procurement is Rs 522.722 Lacs and committed is Rs 11.603 Lacs. Two packages worth Rs 15.675 are still not initiated.
- iii) Total 36 PG students (only 18 years considering 2nd year passed) are getting assistancehip of Rs 8000/- per month.
- iv) 9 PG students published paper in conference/Journal under TEDIP sponsorship.
- v) Total 334 no. of student attended industry visit in different

- v) Total 9 faculties enrolled in Ph.D programme and 9 faculty enrolled in M.Tech and publish 34 no of paper/Journals in international conference under TEDIP-11 till date.
- vi) All packages which are not yet initiated should be immediately started and to be completed within 2 months.
- vii) It is reported that, verification of fixed asset is not yet completed. This should be completed within 1 month and to be reported in next BOG meeting.
- viii) It is observed that, three packages are not initiated. It is requested to the Principal to look after the matter and immediately initiate the remaining packages.
- ix) More publication is expected from faculties and students. Encourage all faculties to do research work and enrol in Ph.D programme.
- x) It is observed that, a good number of PG students have published research paper and journal in national/international conferences. BOG recommends to provide financial assistance from TEDIP and approve the TA, DA norms which forwarded by ITU (Institute TEDIP Unit). Under these norms, total expenditure should not exceed Rs. 100/- and TA, DA as per approved norms.
- xii) The Basic Science department organized a workshop on "Nano Science & Technology" from 19th January to 23th January, 2015. In last BOG meeting the estimated budget submitted was Rs. 6,92,00/- was approved. During the workshop the organizing committee observed the expenditure exceeded of amount Rs. 75,816/-. They have submitted the revised budget and approved by the chairman, BOG and Secretary, BOG on dated 15.02.15 is ratified in the meeting.
- xiii) A proposal from Prof. Suman Majhi for attending present paper in international conference "International Conference on Recent Trends in Nanoscience and Nanotechnology" organized by Department of Physics, Berhampur University, Berhampur, Odisha on 15-16 February, 2015.

line of NPIU for International Travel BOG constitute and expert  
committee including external expert.

Prof. G.C. Layek, Professor, Deptt of Mathematics, Burdwan University  
Prof. Subhasis Bandyopadhyay, Reader, Baruwa Christian College  
BOG forwarded the recommendation letter of ITU along with  
and Security Committee to expert committee.

NPIU organize a workshop on good governance from 14th to 15 Oct, 2014  
Metropolitan Hotel, New Delhi. The chairman, BOG and Principal  
invited to attend that workshop. All expenditure and cancellation  
are approved by BOG, Chairman on dated 16/10/2014 is ratified  
meeting.

Visiting School conducted many effective training programme  
inviting individual experts throughout the year. The honorarium  
such experts is Rs 3000/- per day and TA, DA is Rs 1500/- per day  
allowed. By misunderstanding it is observed that all TA, DA  
not paid without supporting documents. BOG considers all  
such payments as special case, fill this date and not allow such  
payment in future.

BOG approved the revised IDP (Industrial Development Plan)  
→ GDP (Governance Development Plan) in this meeting and  
voted to upload in website.

For professor recruitment in CS & dept. Selection committee  
meeting will be held on 17.06.15. The salary will be paid from TEFIP Fund.

During TEFIP operation it is found some equipments are  
non-functioning after warranty period expired. E.g Two HP  
color laserjet printer out of 4 we procured from TEFIP  
and are not functioning. After initial inspection by  
internal expert it is found that logic card (Rs 15,000/-)  
need be replaced and original cartridge set should be replaced  
(Rs 28,000/-). BOG approved the budget and recommended to  
use original cartridges in future. It is also necessary to  
fill the cartridges of these printers whenever necessary at Rs 500/-

IX A DG set is procured under TEB/18/1 for power backup at library building, computer centre, classroom and Seminar Hall. But during installation by mistake DG set is not connected to classroom and seminar hall. For this additional setup approx budget Rs 850/- is required. BOG approved the budget.

X Most of the ~~the~~ PCs are affected by virus and for this reason it is very difficult to daily operation. That is why a 10 user antivirus needed to be procured for TEB/18 cell and MIS cell. Approx budget is Rs 800/- BOG approved the budget and recommended to procure from IOC of TEB/18.

XI After power cut most of the UPS can't provide power backup due to damage of battery cell in UPS, In TEB/18 Cell & MIS cell there are 10 UPS and to replace 20 cell battery where estimated cost Rs - (Rs 20,000/-)

XII DEEE is a virtual classroom for students where they are taught by faculties of IIT, Bombay or IIT, Chennai. Students participates in this programme where as attendance need to be increased. This is also a mandatory activity of TEB/18 and all expenses towards installation of equipments of DEEE will be from TEB/18. For installation of DTH connection for conducting DEEE class need approx Rs 800/- BOG approve the expenses.

Resolution: After detail deliberations the members unanimously resolved that henceforth all activities of TEB/18 have to be reported prior to approval in paper documents form Synopsis of the different nodal committee meeting is to be sent to the members of BOG in hard copy or through email. It is also resolved that henceforth all developmental activities categorically should be submitted in the BOG meeting. Half year report should be prepared upto 31<sup>st</sup> May and Annual report

up to 31<sup>st</sup> December. It is further resolved that the Principal shall take proper measures to fulfill the objective and shall report it to the next meeting of his taking the initiative.

### Agenda-3 Progress of work towards NBA & Autonomy

Agenda no.3 is taken up for discussion. It is reported by Prof. P. K. Roy that in reference to our application no 179-26/04/2013 for accreditation of 3 UG engineering programs of your Institute, and email received from NBA on 1<sup>st</sup> April, 2015 requesting us propose fresh 5 sets of dates which should be on Friday & Sunday spread over at least 4 months. Accordingly Prof. P. K. Roy has replied to NBA after discussion with the Principal and Prof. Roy apprising 5 sets of dated for their visit as follows.

- 1) 21<sup>st</sup>, 22<sup>nd</sup>, 23<sup>rd</sup> Aug 2015
- 2) 11<sup>th</sup>, 12<sup>th</sup>, 13<sup>th</sup> Sept. 2015
- 3) 30<sup>th</sup>, 31<sup>st</sup> Oct 2015 & 1<sup>st</sup> Nov 2015
- 4) 29<sup>th</sup>, 30<sup>th</sup>, 31<sup>st</sup> Jan 2016
- 5) 26<sup>th</sup>, 27<sup>th</sup>, 28<sup>th</sup> Feb 2016.

Resolution. After detailed deliberation, It is unanimously resolved that achieving NBA is a serious concern and all the faculty members, Lab Assistants and Staff members should be ready in all respect to face the visit of the NBA Team. No-5 Steps taken as Anti ragging measurement as per Govt. guideline.

No-5 is taken up for discussion. The Principal reported that all necessary steps had already been taken towards the prevention of ragging. Accordingly Anti ragging committee, Anti ragging squad had been formed comprising of faculty members, boys and girls students and other required members under the chairmanship of the Principal and is functioning smoothly. The surveillance system installed in the Institute and the Hostel will be very much helpful for this purpose.

Resolution: It is resolved that all precautions should be taken after the admission of the first year. The names and phone numbers of the members in the Anti ragging Committee should be properly displayed in the Institute and Hostel notice board. It is further resolved that the Principal shall take proper care to fulfill the objective and shall report it to the next meeting of his taking the initiative.

No-6 Steps taken for admission of B.Tech & M.Tech of the Academic year 2015-16

No-6 is taken up for discussion. The Assistant Registrar Mr. Ramananda Das reported regarding the steps taken towards the admission process of the Academic session 2015-16 in B.Tech and M.Tech

of all branches. Advertisements are being made in the Bengali newspaper like Anandabazar Patrika, Bartaman in West Bengal and Prabhat Khobor for coverage in Jharkhand. Hoarding advertisement had been given in prime location of Bankura, Kharagpur, Panskura, Dum Dum etc. Handbill had been distributed among the students and guardians during WB JEEB Exam in different location of Bankura, Midnapore and Durgapur. Pre Joint Entrance Assessment Exam was conducted on in Bankura (BUIE), Midnapore (Mohonananda High School), Tamluk and Thakurnagar where quite a good number of students attended the test in Thakurnagar. The web-site of the Institute had been upgraded with latest information of the Institute activities with placement highlights and fees structure.

Faculty members, Lab Assistant and Staffs had been divided into various team to attend pre-counseling in Patna, Ranchi, Dhanbad, Kolkata, Midnapore. ~~BPU~~ APAI is going to conduct the biggest counseling at Netaji Indoor Stadium, Kolkata during 13-06-15 to 16-06-2015 and the team of BUIE will attend the programme to motivate the probable students and to maximize the admission. It is discussed that keeping view of less admission in the department of CSE, ECE, A&E & IT through lateral entry, some measures should be take so that more students gets attracted to take admission through lateral entry.

It is also discussed that due to paucity of TE&IP fund, it may not be possible to award Teaching Assistantship to the PG students which may lead to less admission in M.Tech.

Resolution It is unanimously resolved to extend all necessary help to the admission team. The Institute will remain open on all working days during the summer vacation and roster duty to be allotted to all employees of the Institute.

It is also resolved that 5% discount on fees may be given to the students who will get admitted through
