Prof. Nilan Harza, chairman B.O.G presided over the meeting. Proceeding of the B.O.G meeting no. 57 held on 10th February, 2014 is read over, discussed and confirmed.

1. Status of the TE&IP activities is stated by the TE&IP Coordinator

Prof. Subhojit Roy. The following issues are elaborated and discussed.

a. The TE&IP project had been extended from Dec., 2014 to Dec., 2016 by NPIU. Accordingly an action plan along with additional budget of Rs 5 crore had been discussed with the Nodal Officers and TE&IP-Head and prepared and submitted to SPFU.

b. An action plan and budget prepared for the period from July, 2014 to December, 2016 the following new packages for procurement have been proposed in anticipation of

additional fund being provided by the Govt. of India for this extended period.

(c) It is felt as essential to inculcate Research culture amongst our faculty members, and measures should be taken to motivate the faculty members to start their PhD works. To encourage faculty members to venture into innovative research works, TEF&IP provides the scope of giving seed grants to the deserving candidates under R&D. It is, therefore, proposed that system of giving seed grants to the maximum limit of Rs. 50,000/- per head for potentially innovative research proposals may be introduced in our Institute under TEF&IP. A committee of experts may be constituted by the BOG for evaluation and recommendation for awarding the proposed Seed grants.

(d) Procurement plan of our Institute under TEF&IP-II was initially prepared in December 2011 consisting of 117 number of packages for Rs. 5.3 crore with the approval of the chairman and the Secretary and the same was uploaded in PMSS. Subsequently in consideration of requirements in different times the initial procurement plan has been revised with the approval of the Chairman and the Secretary as detailed below.

(e) Report on different trainings undergone by faculties under FSD and students under Finishing Schools had been placed. IIT-cell activities are also elaborated. It is suggested by Prof. Dr. Hafiz Khan to prepare the report in more specific and in details. One proposal of attending International Conference is submitted for BOG approval by Prof. Aloke Roy, Associate Prof., Deptt of CS&E for presenting a paper at ICFIT, Bangkok as the presenter author. Prof. Siddhartha Bandyopadhyay suggested that this type of international papers should be published which will be beneficial for scoring in NBA etc.

(f) As per TE818 guidelines we are providing teaching assistantship @ Rs 800/- per month to 54 non-grade students (both 1st & 2nd year). Now in Action Plan we proposed to increase the number to 60 (both 1st & 2nd year) and the requirement of fund is projected accordingly.

(g) cost of operation & maintenance including electricity, water, generate facilities are provided to the TE818 cell, it is decided that a lump sum amount of Rs 50/- per month will be charged by the college to TE818 for the above service till project ends.

(b) NBA visit for accreditation of three eligible courses may be held anytime after August, 2014, one of serious shortfalls in our Institute is the absence of Senior and PhD faculty especially in CSF, EE & ECE departments. It is therefore very much essential to recruit such faculty members for the aforesaid three departments that applied for accreditation.

Resolution:- It is resolved the reports of all activities should be submitted in details mentioning name & title of training. B.O.G approves the additional budget and procurement plan. The application for attending the international conference by Prof. Shoke Roy is approved by the B.O.G. It is also decided that special drives for recruitment/recruiting senior/PhD faculties for the M.Tech courses with salary from TE&IP fund may be initiated.

2/ Prof. Shoke Roy reported regarding NBA activities. A letter had been received from NBA to send a fresh 5 set of dates of visit and accordingly a letter had been sent suggesting dates in the span of August to November, 2014, considering the when there will be minimum number of students be present in the college. Other points discussed are as follows:

- a. Partitioning of Laboratory for the Deptt of CSF and ECE to meet the NBA requirement is under process under TE&IP.
- b. Documentation activities of the faculty members are going on. Prof. Shoke Roy, Dr. Krishnendu Bhattacharya and Prof. Pradip Bhattacharya regularly meet the HODs, faculty members and Laboratory Assistants of CSF, ECE and EE Deptt to check and accelerate the activities.
- c. The Committee is also trying to invite an expert in this field to conduct a mock NBA visit. The chairman requested Prof. SS Datta to have a Bandopadhyay to visit the college at his convenience to guide us and to help us to identify and rectify our errors in NBA preparation.

Resolution:- It is resolved that more emphasis should be given to completion of the partitioning of different Laboratory and reclassification to finish the job at the earliest so that it

becomes ready before NBA visit. Efforts should be made from all concern to gear the NBA visit successfully.

3. Mr. D.K. Sengupta, Placement Officer submitted the placement report of 2014 batch and he stated that 721 of the total students had been placed in 37 placement drives. He also suggested that a placement Officer can be set up in Salt Lake area where most of the IT companies are present.




4. Miscellaneous
