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TENDER CONDITIONS:

1. The Tenderer shall quote his rate as per NIT & the Terms and Conditions enclosed in the Tender document.
2. Tenderers are advised to inspect and examine the site and its surroundings and satisfy themselves before submitting their tenders as to the nature of the roof (so far as is practicable), the form and nature of the site, the means of access to the site, the accommodation they may require and in general shall themselves obtain all necessary information as to risks, contingencies and other circumstances which may influence or affect their tender. A tenderer shall be deemed to have full knowledge of the site whether he inspects it or not and no extra charges consequent on any misunderstanding or otherwise shall be allowed. The tenderer shall be responsible for arranging and maintaining at his own cost all materials, tools & plants, water, electricity access, facilities for workers and all other services required for executing the work unless otherwise specifically provided for in the contract documents and has made himself aware of the scope and specifications of the work to be done and of conditions and rates at which stores, tools and plant, etc. will be issued to him by the University and local conditions and other factors having bearing on the execution of the work.
3. Tenders should be valid for 90 days from the date of opening of the tenders and may have to be extended further if considered necessary by the Institute. No reasons will be assigned for extension and no withdrawal shall be allowed. If any tenderer withdraws his tender before the said period or issue of letter of acceptance, which-ever is earlier, or makes any modifications in the terms and conditions of the tender which are not acceptable to the Institute, then the Institute shall, without prejudice to any other right or remedy, be at liberty to forfeit the said Earnest Money Deposit.
4. The time allowed for completing the work will be 30 (thirty) days from the issue of work Order.
5. No Telex/ Tele fax/ Telegram/ E-mail of the Techno-Commercial and Price bids will be accepted. The Institute is not responsible for Postal/ Courier delays. The parties have to ensure the receipt of bids well in time.
6. If the date of tender submission and opening happens to be unforeseen holiday, the same will be postponed to the next working day without any further intimation.
7. The Institute does not bind itself to accept lowest tender and reserves the right to reject any or all the tenders received with or without disclosing any reason thereof. All tenders in which any of the prescribed condition is not fulfilled or any condition put forth by the tenderer, shall be summarily rejected.
8. Canvassing whether directly or indirectly, in connection with tenders is strictly prohibited and the tender submitted by the contractors who resort to canvassing will be summarily rejected.
9. This Notice Inviting Tender shall form a part of the contract document.
10. The successful tenderer/ contractor, on acceptance of his tender by the Institute, shall within 15 days from the stipulated date of start of the work sign the contract agreement in standard form consisting of the notice inviting tender, all the documents including additional conditions, specifications and drawings, if any, forming the tender as issued at the time of invitation of tender and acceptance thereof together with any correspondence leading thereto.
11. No materials will be supplied by the Institute.

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12. In case of delay in completion of the work within the stipulated time due to reasons attributable to the contractor, Standard Liquidated Damage @ 0.1% of the tender accepted value shall be recovered for each week of delay from the final bill or the part thereof.

13. The contractor shall obtain a valid license under the contract labour (R&A) Act, 1970, and the contract labour central rules 1971, during the commencement of the work, and continue to have a valid license until the completion of the work. The contractor shall also abide by the provisions of the Child Labour (Prohibition and Regulation) Act, 1986 and other labour laws. Any failure to fulfill this requirement shall attract the penal provisions of this contract arising out of the resultant non-execution of the work. No labour below the age of fourteen years shall be employed on the work.

14. During Opening of tender only representative duly authorized by the agency / contractor will be allowed to be present.

15. All relevant documents submitted with the tender should be self attested (by the agency/contractor) and on demand original copy must be produced failing which tender will not be considered.

16. Authenticity of signatory (contractor) of tender document will be verified before finalization of tender document.

17. Tax at higher of prescribed rate or 30% will be deducted on all transactions liable to TDS, where the permanent Account Number (PAN) of the deductee is not available.

18. In case of any dispute, it would be referred to a sole Arbitrator to be appointed by the Institute authority. The decision of the sole Arbitrator will be final and binding to both the parties.

19. 3% security money of successful bidder will be retained by the Institute from the bill value which shall be released after 01(one) year of satisfactory completion of work.

20. If the work is found not as per specification or abandoned by the executing contractor/agency, same will be cancelled and remaining work will be done through other contractor/agency at their cost & risk.

21. Detailed computerized measurement entry in the measurement sheet (location wise) has to be made by the contractor and to be submitted to Registrar's Section for joint verification by the Institute Engineers and the Contractor. The joint verification has to be arranged by the Contractor but must have to take permission from the Registrar's End.

22. Before procuring any major items like cement/ steel/ coarse & fine sand/ stone aggregate etc., the Contractor must take prior permission/ submit test report as per the direction of Registrar's section (if required).

23. Bidders must follow the special conditions of contract.

24. Those bidders, who accept the above terms and conditions, may submit their tender along with all relevant documents and a copy of above terms and conditions of the tender duly signed.

25. The Institute reserves the right to modify any aspect of this tender document, including but not limited to specifications, deadlines, and terms and conditions, at its sole discretion even after accepting the contract.

SECTION – III: GENERAL CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT

1. SUBMISSION OF TENDER

(a) The General Conditions of Contract for CPWD/PWD Works shall be the guiding principles for this work. Tenderers are advised to procure the same and familiarize themselves with the provisions of the above mentioned Conditions of Contract.

(b) The Institute reserves the right to alter, modify any Tender Conditions, technical specifications etc., before tender opening and may seek fresh quotation depending upon necessity, and may even withdraw/ cancel the tender, without assigning any reason what so ever.

(c) All amendments/ revisions to tender documents issued by the Institute, if any, must be signed and submitted along with the tender. The tenderers are advised to submit the tender based strictly on the terms and conditions and specifications contained in the tender documents, and not to stipulate any deviations.

1.2 Tenders shall be prepared and submitted in sealed envelope super scribed as “Tender No..... Dated :..... DUE FOR OPENING ON FOR THE WORK

“. The full name, Postal address, telegraphic address and telex/ telefax /telephone No. of the tenderer shall be written at the bottom left corner of the sealed envelope.

1.3 Insertion, postscript, addition and alteration shall not be recognized unless confirmed by the Tenderers signature.

In the event of the tender being submitted by a firm, it must be signed separately by each partner thereof or in the event of the absence of any partner, it must be signed on his behalf by a person holding a power of attorney.

2. TENDERER TO INFORM HIMSELF FULLY

The tenderer is required to carefully examine the technical specifications and other details relating to the work given in the Tender documents and fully inform himself as to all conditions and matters that may effect the work or the cost thereof. The tenderer shall be deemed to have independently obtained all necessary information for the purpose of submitting the tender and his tender as accepted shall be deemed to have taken into account all contingencies as may arise due to such information or lack of **the same.**


3. VALIDITY OF THE TENDER

Tender shall remain valid for acceptance for a period of not less than 90 days.

4. CLARIFICATIONS

The Tender Document issued is complete in all respect and no further clarifications are elaborated. However, in so far Technical Clarifications if any are concerned even though not binding on Institute can be ascertained from the Institute.

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5. QUOTATION OF PRICE / RATES

This being item rate tender, the tenderer shall state at what rate he will be willing to undertake the work. Rate should be quoted in item rate basis.

6. COMPLETION TIME

The completion time is the essence of the contract. The Tenderer shall complete the work within the period indicated in the Notice Inviting Tender i.e 30days after receiving the work order.

7. TRANSFER OF TENDER DOCUMENTS/ TENDERS

Transfer of tender documents purchased by one tenderer to another is not permissible. Similarly transfer of tenders submitted by one tenderer to another is not permissible under any circumstances. The alteration of essence of tender once submitted is also not permissible.

8. LANGUAGE

The Tender shall be submitted in English language only.

9. NO CLAIM FOR COMPENSATION FOR SUBMISSION OF TENDER

The Tenderer whose tender is not accepted shall not be entitled to claim any costs, charges and expenses of any incidental to or incurred by him thorough or in connection with his submission of tender, even though the Institute may modify/ withdraw the Tender.

10. TENDER EVALUATION

The Tenders received and accepted will be evaluated to ascertain the best and lowest workable tender in the interest of the Institute, for the complete work covered under the technical specifications and documents.

11. DEFINITIONS

a) Unless otherwise required by the subject or context the terms herein below shall have the following meanings.

The **Contract** means the documents forming the tender and acceptance thereof and the formal agreement executed between the competent authority on behalf of Bankura Unnayani Institute of Engineering and the Contractor, together with the documents referred to therein including these conditions, the specifications, designs, drawings and instructions issued from time to time by the Registrar's Section or Engineer assigned from the Institute, Bankura Unnayani Institute of Engineering and all the these documents taken together, shall be deemed to form one contract and shall be complementary to one another.

b) **Client** means Bankura Unnayani Institute of Engineering acting through the Registrar/Engineer In Charge, Bankura Unnayani Institute of Engineering, Bankura.

c) **The Contractor** shall mean the individual, firm, agency or company, whether incorporated or not, undertaking the works and shall include the legal personal representative of such individual or the persons composing such firm, agency or company, or the successors of such firm or company and the permitted assigns of such individual, firm, agency or company.

d) The expression **works or work** shall, unless there be something either in the subject or context repugnant to such construction, be construed and taken to mean the works by or by virtue of the

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contract contracted to be executed whether temporary or permanent, and whether original, altered, substituted or additional.

e) The **site** shall mean the roof or other places, on, into or through which work is to be executed under the contract or any adjacent roof/place, path or street which may be allotted or used for the purpose of carrying out the contract.

f) **Tender Value** means the value of the entire work as stipulated in the letter of award.

g) Where the context so requires, words imparting the singular only also include the plural and vice versa. Any reference to masculine gender shall whenever required include feminine gender and vice versa.

h) As stated in Section III, Clause 1.1, the General Conditions of Contract for Central PWD Works shall be the guiding principles for this tender. The Clauses of Contract mentioned therein shall also be applicable herein and only those Clauses that need addition, emphasis and modification in context of this tender are enumerated below. Contractors are once again advised to familiarize themselves with the General Conditions of Contract for Central PWD Works.

12. SIGNING OF CONTRACT AGREEMENT

a) On the tender being accepted by the Client, a formal contract may be signed and executed by and between the Client and the successful tenderer within a time to be fixed by the Client, which may prior to start of the work or shall anyhow be within 7 days from the stipulated date of start of the work.

b) The contractor shall be furnished, free of cost one certified copy of the contract documents except standard specifications, Schedule of Rates and such other printed and published documents, together with all drawings as may be forming part of the tender papers. None of these documents shall be used for any purpose other than that of this contract.

13. SCOPE OF WORK

a) The work to be carried out under the Contract shall, except as otherwise provided in these conditions, include all labour, materials, tools, plants, equipment and transport which may be required in preparation of and for and in the full and entire execution and completion of the works. The descriptions given in the Schedule of Quantities shall, unless otherwise stated, be held to include wastage on materials, carriage and cartage, carrying and return of empties, hoisting, setting, fitting and fixing in position and all other labours necessary in and for the full and entire execution and completion of each work as aforesaid in accordance with good practice and recognized principles.

b) The contractor shall be deemed to have satisfied himself before tendering as to the correctness and sufficiency of his tender for the works and of the rates and prices quoted in price bid which rates and prices shall, except as otherwise provided, cover all his obligations under the Contract and all matters and things necessary for the proper completion and maintenance of the works.

14. DISCREPANCIES AND ADJUSTMENT OF ERRORS

a) The several documents forming the Contract are to be taken as mutually explanatory of one another, detailed drawings being followed in preference to small scale, drawing and figured dimensions in preference to scale and special conditions in preference to General Conditions as well as special conditions.

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b) If there are varying or conflicting provisions made in any one document forming part of the contract, the Registrar, Bankura Unnayani Institute of Engineering shall be the deciding authority with regard to the intention/ interpretation of the document and his decision shall be final and binding on the contractor.

c) Any error in description, quantity or rate in Schedule of Quantities or any omission there from shall not vitiate the contract or release the Contractor from the execution of the whole or any part of the works comprised therein according to drawings and specifications or from any of his obligations under the contracts.

15. The works should be completed within 30 days after Issuance of work order. Any willful delay will render bidders to pay liquidated damages. @ Rs. 1% of contract value per week which will be deducted from payments due to him.

16. Bidders cannot withdraw their offer after opening of the bids.

17. The bidders shall take all safety precautions for the safety of his employees/workers and the Institute shall not be, in any way, liable for any damage/ liability on account of any mishap or negligence of the contractor.

18. Bidders shall be responsible for any mishap/accident and liability, if any, falling thereof, shall be entirely yours and the Institute shall in no way be responsible for the same.

19. TERMS OF PAYMENT

Subject to any deduction, which the client may be entitled to make under the Contract, all payments to contractor for the work would be made by Cheque / Demand Draft in favour of the contractor on satisfactory completion report and signing of the computerized Measurement Book & bill by Site (i/c) of the proposed work and Registrar, Bankura Unnayani Institute of Engineering without which payment will not be released. The Computerized measurement sheet must be submitted by the concerned contractor of the work for verification by the site i/c and Registrar/Engineer in charge before finalization of payment of bill, payments will be made in the following phases and completion of each phases will be decided by Registrar/ Engineer in Charge, Bankura Unnayani Institute of Engineering.

Phase	% of Payment
1 st phase On material delivery (all materials)	First 20% payment will be released.
2 nd Phase	Next 20% Payment will be released after completion of 50% of the entire work.
3 rd Phase	Next 40% Payment will be released after completion of total 80% of the entire work.
4 th Phase	Next 17% Payment will be released after completion entire work.

3% of the Total work value will be retained as a security deposit and will be released depending upon the condition as stated below.

20. SECURITY DEPOSIT

3% Security Deposit will be retained by the Institute from the bill value, which shall be released after one year from the date of completion of the work subject to realization of the Institute. During this defect liability period, any defect(s) in the work done shall be rectified by the Contractor at his/her own cost and expenses, failing which recovery shall be done from the security deposit in part or full as the case may be.

21. SUB CONTRACTING OF THE WORK

The Contractor is not permitted to assign or transfer his/ their obligation or benefit under the contract either in full or in part of the work to other individuals/ firms / agencies.

22. The Engineer-In-Charge or such other person as may be authorized by the institute shall hold meeting once in a week where the second party or his representative at site will submit the latest information including progress report and difficulties if any, in the execution of the work. The whole team may jointly inspect the site on a particular day to take stock of activities.

23. All materials must be of Jindal steel.

SECTION – IV: SPECIAL CONDITION OF CONTRACT

1. Work should be executed as per but not limited to drawing provided in annexure III (Part I, Part II & Part III)
2. All screw whatsoever applied to the structure should be **self-drilling screw**.
3. **4 sided strips** should be applied to all members' **welding**.
4. Welding **strips/sticks** must be of "**ESAB**" (**Ferrosil**).
5. **Primers** should be applied to all member of each truss after that **Red color paint** should be applied on it.
Primers are of 1 (one) coat and red colorpaint are of 2 (two) coats. (Both are of **Asian paint** with appropriate (best) class, category and dilution as per application booklet for that particular paint and primer).
6. **Roof Top shed** must be of **Red color**.
7. **Jhalat** must be of **Ivory Color**.
8. Institute will **not allow** any kind of **drill above the roof** (except parapet wall).
9. Additional drawings should be drawn by the bidders (if required) but the same should be applicable after final verification of Registrar's End.
10. Concrete used for the construction of the base must be of M20 Grade (i.e 1:1.5:3); cement must be of Ultratech Cement.



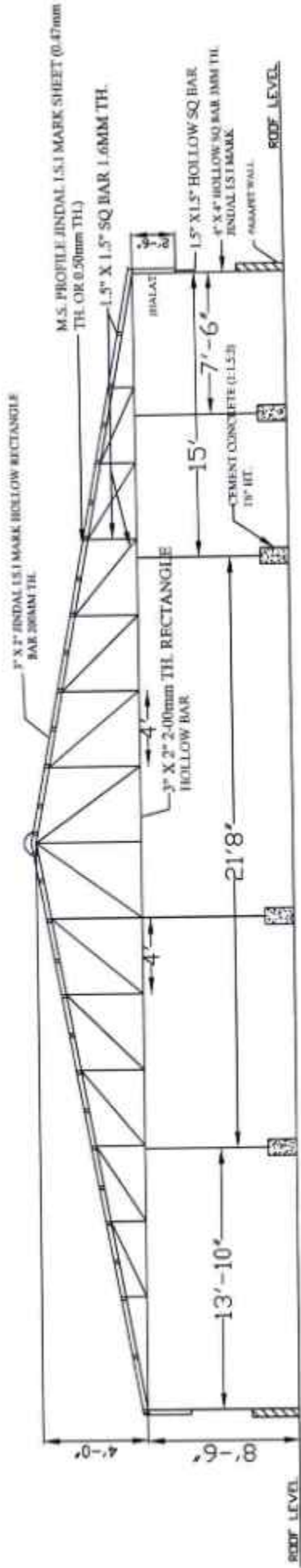

M.S. STRUCTURAL WORKS FOR ROOF TRUSS OVER ADMINISTRATIVE BUILDING

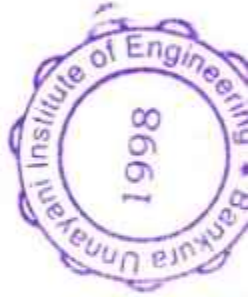

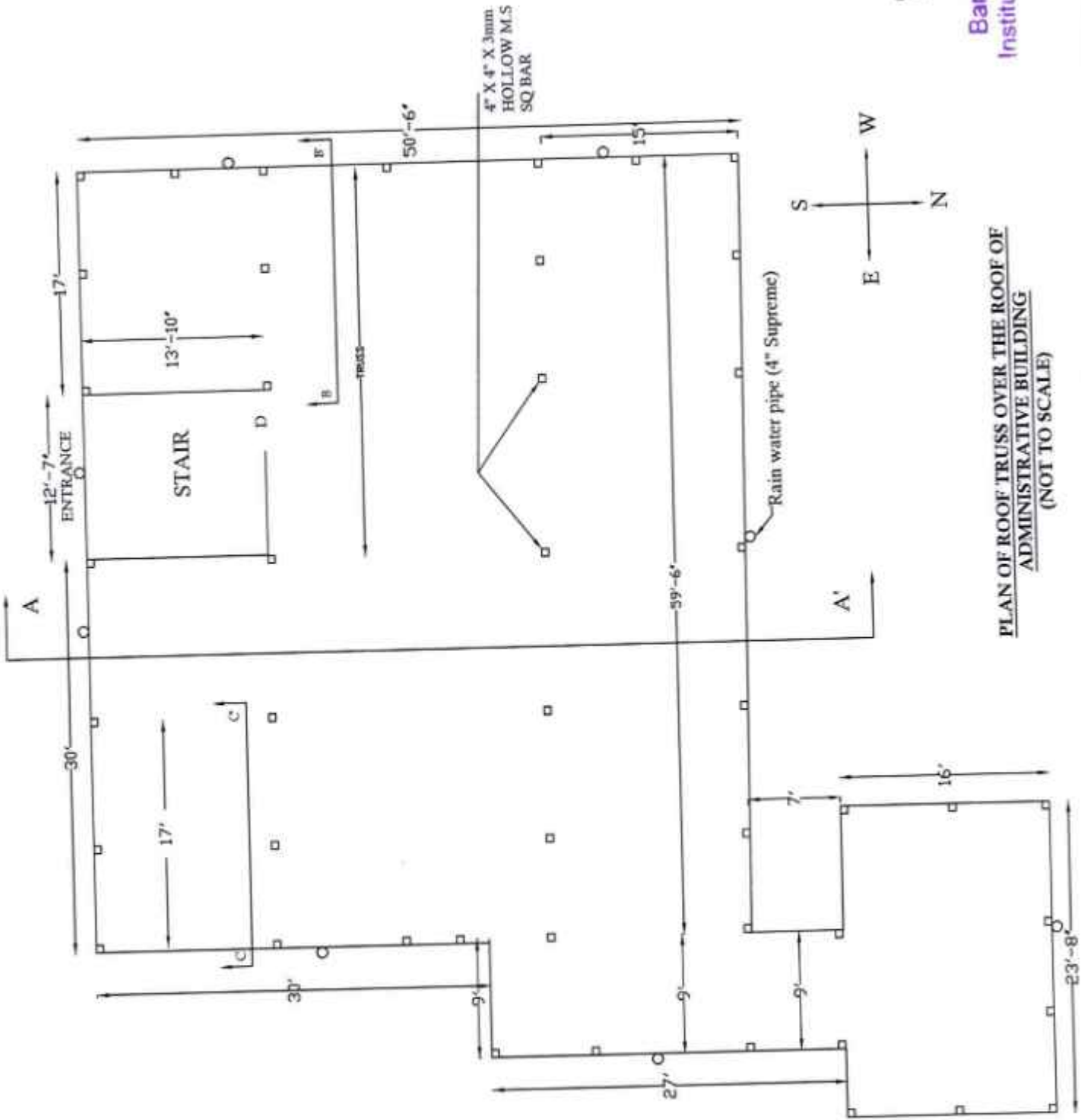


SECTION ON- B-B' & C-C' (NOT TO SCALE)
